



Trout Unlimited Shasta Trinity Cascades Annual Sacramento River Cleanup

Date: Saturday, April 22 (Earth Day!)

Time: 8:00 am – 2:00 pm

Details: We will meet at 8:00 am at the Posse Grounds Boat Ramp. There we will divide into two groups: one group in boats and a second group on foot. Heavy-duty Garbage Bags will be provided.

If you have a drift boat, raft, small jetboat, or even standup paddleboard, please show up a bit early to launch your boat and coordinate shuttles to Bonnyview Boat Ramp. There will most likely be space available for people without a vessel to hop in one of the boats. Regardless, everyone who will be in a boat on the water needs to have an approved life jacket.

For those on foot, we'll coordinate an effort to walk the shores in several of the popular access spots on the Sacramento River in Redding.

There will be a large dumpster set up at the Bonnyview Boat Ramp.

What to Bring: Protective gloves, comfortable work clothes and good footwear (for climbing around in the water, brush, and rocks along the river corridor), plus sun protection. Please be sure to bring water, and keep hydrated!

Bonus: When the cleanup is over, all participants are invited to join the **Whole Earth and Watershed Festival, from 11 am-5 pm at Redding City Hall & Sculpture Park (<http://wholeearthandwatershedfestival.org/>)** .
